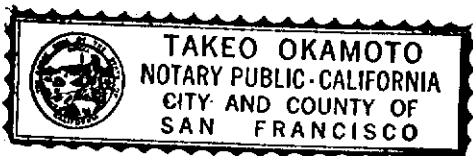

JAPAN AIR LINES CO., LTD. As a public relations counsel we advise this company on its promotional activities in connection with its international operations, the establishment of new routes and offices, and its publicity programs.

JAPAN TRADE CENTER of San Francisco - We assist this client in developing activities to promote knowledge in the United States of Japanese products and of the potential markets in Japan for expanded American exports to that nation. We also conduct market studies.

CONSULATE GENERAL OF JAPAN at San Francisco - We function as public relations counsel to the Consul General, advising on local community relations and assist in correlating economic data.

UNITED STATES - JAPAN TRADE COUNCIL - We serve primarily as the Western Office of the Council, coordinating data-gathering activities. (In the past, from time to time, we prepared and disseminated, within the Western states, news releases pertaining to two-way U.S.-Japan trade and we disseminated pamphlets prepared and published at the Washington offices of the Council. However, in the calendar year of 1971 all dissemination of Council materials in the area originally covered by our office has been done directly from the Council's Washington offices.) In addition, we serve the Council in making arrangements for special projects, such as seminars and symposia in various cities of the United States.

EMBASSY OF JAPAN at Washington - We function as consultants to the Embassy providing evaluations on current U.S.-Japan economic relations and trends in international commerce. We assist, from time to time, in the physical arrangements of events involving the personal appearance of the Ambassador of Japan.
