It is hereby agreed that Tanaka, Walders & Ritger shall provide the Embassy of Japan with legal and informational counseling services with respect to matters relating to U.S.-Japan trade relations, at an annual retainer of U.S. \$21,600.00 (Twenty-one Thousand Six Hundred Dollars) for the period April 1, 1977, through March 31, 1978.
